The licensee is responsible for the renewal of this licence before the expiry date and for ensuring that the mailing address is current. Penalties apply for using or selling radiation apparatus and/or radioactive substances without holding a current and appropriate licence.

CONDITIONS OF LICENCE

For S2 the licensee shall:

1 Sell a radioactive substance only to a person who holds a current licence, issued under the Act, which permits the purchaser to use that activity of that radioactive substance for the purpose indicated on the licence.

2 Ensure that all packages containing a radioactive substance, sold by the licensee, are transported in accordance with clause 23 of the Regulation

DICTIONARY

Act means the Radiation Control Act 1990.

Ampere (A) means a unit of electric current.

Authority means the Environment Protection Authority.

Becquerel (Bq) means a unit of radioactivity equivalent to 1 disintegration per second.

Manager means the Manager, Hazardous Materials and Radiation Section

General Supervision means supervision by a qualified person who

oversees the person being supervised and ensures that the person follows safe radiation work practices in relation to the use of radioactive substances or radiation apparatus.

Gray (Gy) means a unit of radiation exposure equivalent to the deposition of 1 Joule per kilogram of material.

Immediate Supervision means supervision by a qualified person who is present at all times during, and is observing and directing, the use by the person being supervised of radioactive substances or radiation apparatus

Medical practitioner means a person who holds a current registration under the Medical Practice Act 1992.

Qualified person in relation to supervision for a particular radioactive substance or item of radiation apparatus, means a person who is the holder of a licence which allows the person to provide supervision with respect to that substance or item.

Regulation means the Radiation Control Regulation 2003.

Tracer study means the deliberate and planned release of a radioactive substance into the environment for the purpose of studying the transfer of matter.

Volts peak (Vp) means a unit of electrical potential.

u x 10⁻⁶, m x 10⁻³, k x 10³, M x 10⁶, G x 10⁹, T x 10¹², P x 10¹⁵
